From Herrick Genealogy.

EDWARD HERRICK married on Oct.9, 1744, Sara (Mary elsewhere) Kimball, of Boxford. He was taxed in Topsfield, 1745. He d. in Methuen, Sept. 22, 1756. Their children were :-

Lydia, bapt. in Wenham, June 2, 1751; m. Parker Richardson of Methuen, son of Caleb Richardson of ANDOVER.

Sara, bapt. same day as Lydia; m. 1st., -- Tray; 2nd., Safford; 3rd. --- Abbott.

Mary, bapt. with other two.

Anna. " " " ; m. George Dodge of Salem; moved to Effingham, N.H. and then back to Salem.

Ben, b. Dec.6, 1752; m. 1775, Sara Abbott; she was b. Sept.14, 1751, dau. of Jos.(4) Abbott and w. Anna Peabody. (Jos.(3) Jn.(2) Geo.(1). Ben Herrick d. at sea; she m. 2nd., 1789, Wm. Whittier of Methuen.

Edward, b. Oct.9, 1754; m. Mary Holt; moved to Wilton; he d. Feb.5, 1811.

John, b. Oct.6, 1756; m. Mary Lawrence, dau. of Elija; he d. Dec.9, 1820; Mary m. 2nd., Isaac Blunt, of ANDOVER.

Anna Herrick (dau. of Edward) and husband, George Dodge, had: p- ---

Larkin Dodge, b. ; m. Abigail Mason, dau. of Col. Stephen Mason of Moultonboro and w. Elizabeth Dalton; Larkin d. of smallpox; his widow m. 2nd., Deacon Mark Newman of ANDOVER.

EDWARD HERRICK, of Methuen, above, was b. June 6, 1724, son of Ben Herrick and w. Lydia Hayward, who were m. Nov.27, 1720. Ben Herrick, was b. Apr.14, 1700, son of Jos. Herrick and w. Elizabeth. Ben settled in Wenham and Beverly and finally went to Sage's Ferry, Methuen; he d. 1773.

Joseph Herrick, father of Ben, and grandfather of Edward, lived in Beverly near the Wenham line and kept a tavern. He moved to Marblehead, then to a farm on Mine Hill, Topsfield. He died 1749; Elizabeth, d. 1748. He was son of Jos.(2) Herrick of Cherry Hill, Salem and w. Sara Leach, who were m. Feb.7, 1667; she d. 1674; Jos. m. 2nd., Mary Endicott of Salem, 1678; she d. 1706; he d. 1718. He was bap. Aug.6, 1645, son of Henry(1) Herrick of Salem, and w. Edith Lasker..
