

The MONTGOMERY FAMILY

of ANDOVER.

JOHN MONTGOMERY, who died here in Andover, March 4, 1802, was born in 1730 in County Armagh, Ireland. He came to America in 1749 and went to Londonderry, N.H. There he married Mary Knox. She was b. 1722, daughter of Capt. John Knox and wife, Mary(2) Montgomery of the line of Hugh(1) and wife, Jane Mc Gregor.
