Hannah Richardson, daughter of Caleb Richardson and Abigail Kneeland, born 1801, married James Roberts, widower, of Andover, in Medford, 1860. Her sister, Lydia Richardson, married Nathaniel Sylvester, a maker of patterns for shoes, who moved to Boston or Malden and then to Nova Scotia. Lydia died and so did James Roberts, so Hannah, widow of James, married her brother-in-law, Nathaniel Sylvester.

Louisa, a daughter of Nathaniel and Lydia Sylvester, was born July, 1835/

A Joshua Silvester was taxed here in 1807 to 1818. His estate was administered by his widow Lucy, who paid the tax 1818-1820. Capt. Timothy Poor paid on the Silvester property, 1821.
