

March 14 Cuddle and Craft: Sheep and Lambs

3D Spring Lamb Craft: Materials from Arty Crafty Kids

Blue, Black & White Card Stock
Green Paper
Cotton Wool
Scissors
Glue Stick



Step 1: Draw/trace the pieces you see above onto white card



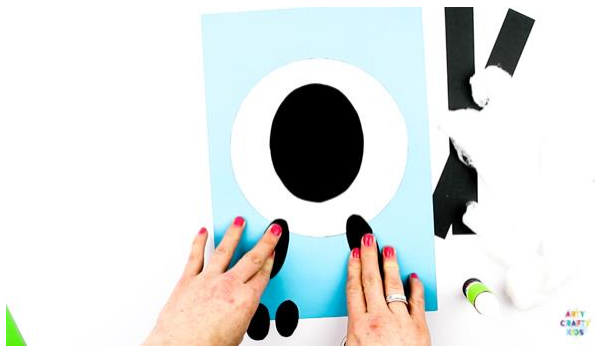
Step 2: Cut out the lamb elements.



Step 3: Stick the large circle to the sheet of blue card.



Step 4: Using black card, trace the remaining elements. You will need to create a pair of legs and ears, 4 oval shapes.



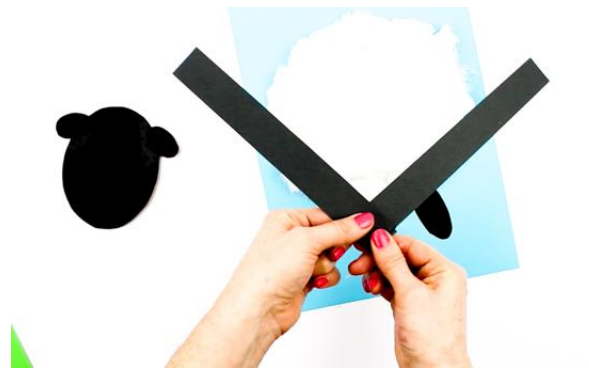
Step 5: Attach the lamb's legs to the bottom of the white circle.



Step 6: Attach the smaller ovals to the sides of the lamb's head.



Step 7: Leaving a large round space in the middle, fill the lamb's body with cotton balls.

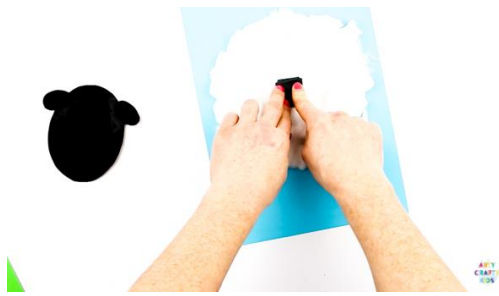


Step 8: Using scissors or a paper cutter, cut out two even strips of colored paper – ideally, the strips will be fairly wide and for length, I would recommend cutting the paper from the shortest side of an A4 piece of paper.

Take the two strips and position them in a 90° angle as shown above. Glue the connecting papers together.



Step 9: Fold the bottom strip over the top and crease the fold along the edge. This will make the accordion fold tight!
Continue this process until all the is paper has been folded.
Seal the ends with glue.



Step 10: Stick one end of the accordion fold to the center of the lamb's body.



Step 11: Attach the head to the other end. The lambs head will now bounce and wobble! Complete the lamb with a pair of eyes!



Step 12: Complete the 3D Spring Lamb Craft with a strip of green paper, cutting irregular triangles out of one side to create the impression of grass.
