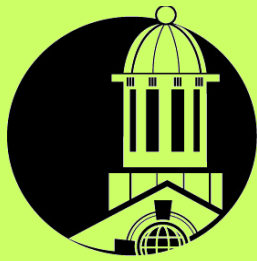

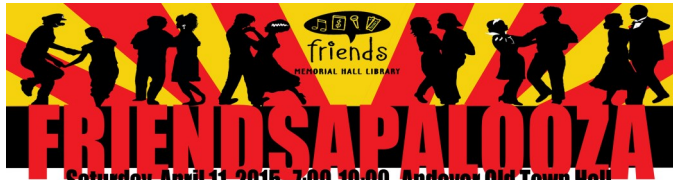


**Creating the Andover Historic Mill District:
