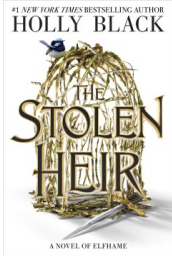

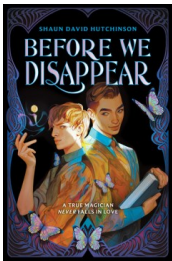

the emperor in an all-woman army.

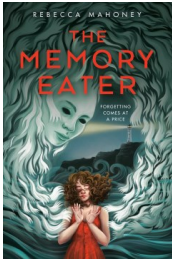


The mermaid, the witch, and the sea

way to a dreaded arranged marriage.

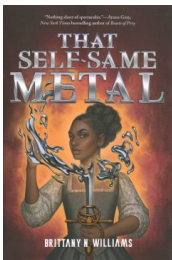


The memory eater

draws Joan into political intrigue in both human and Fae worlds.



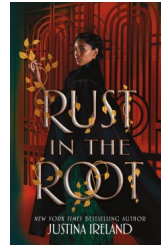
Amari and the night brothers

secret is exposed.



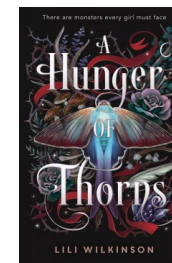
Crumbs
