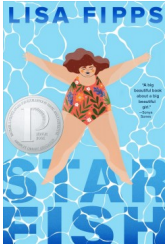

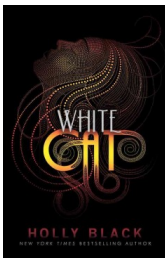
inheritance.

A debut novel-in-verse follows the experiences of a girl who tries to change her behavior when she is bullied for her weight, before a swimming hobby, a kind therapist

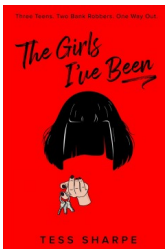
and an accepting new neighbor help her embrace her true self.

The girls I've been

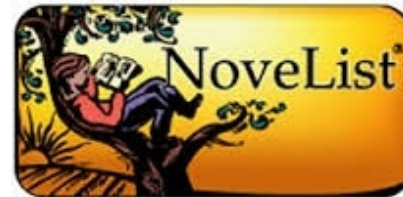

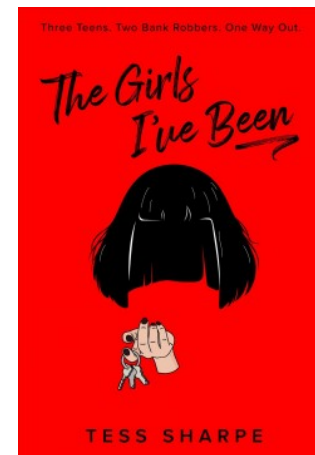

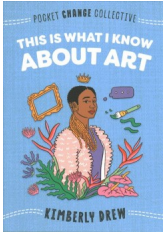
Iron widow

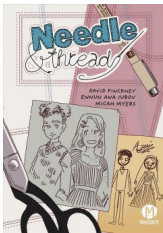

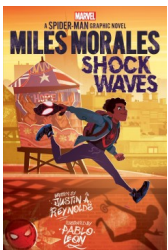
Vampires never get old
