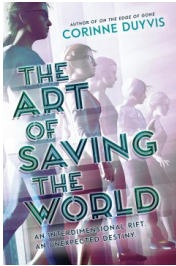


The last cuentista

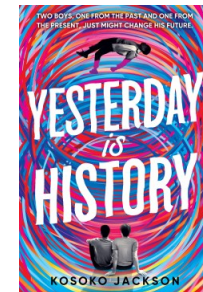


All that's left in the world
