Purpose:

Students entering 11th and 12th grades in September will gain valuable volunteer work experience and earn community service hours.



The Program:

Students will be trained to use all of Memorial Hall Library's makerspace equipment. They will be scheduled to work in the makerspace alongside a library staff person and will assist patrons as needed.

Commitment:

Acceptance into the program requires attendance at one of the mandatory training sessions (3 hours) and participation in a minimum of six 2-hour long volunteer blocks (12 hours) scheduled by the program coordinators. The **minimum** time commitment over the course of the summer is 15 hours.

- 2. Fill out the application.
- 3. Email the application to volunteer@mhl.org.
- 4. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis.
- 5. The final day to apply is Sunday, May 5, 2024.
- 6. Interviews will be scheduled for select candidates. Space in the program is limited.
- 7. Applicants will be accepted into the program at the discretion of the coordinators.
- 8. All applicants will be notified by May 28, 2024.
